The "Law of Sowing and Reaping"

"Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap.

For he who sows to his flesh will of the flesh reap corruption, but he who sows to the Spirit will of the Spirit reap everlasting life."

Galatians 6: 7-8

Sow to the flesh . . .

- Consequences for cultivating/caring for flesh
- God intends for the pain of these consequences to reveal sin, lead us to repentance, and set us on path to restoration
- Consequences create a "healthy hedge"

Facing consequences

- We face consequences of our own sin
 - Confess
 - Repent
 - Restoration
 - Restitution
- We encourage others to face the consequences of their sins

Breaking down this "hedge"...

- Creates deception that there are no consequences for sinful behavior
 - Foothold/Stronghold
- Inhibits spiritual growth
 - In self
 - In others
- Leads to rebellion and idolatry

Cultivating this "hedge"...

- Sowing to the Spirit means reaping everlasting life
 - For you
 - For your children
 - For your spouse
 - For your family
 - For your friends

Cultivating this "hedge"...

- Sowing to the Spirit means that as we stop enabling and interrupting the consequences, we yield to the plan of God in the lives of our loved ones.
- This positions us to teach the truth of God's word - and to be a life which is a canvas truth is painted on.

"We will reap what we sow"

- Encourages us to go to God
 - For forgiveness
 - To claim His promises
- Great motivator to sow good stuff
- Great reality check
- Reveals lies, footholds, strongholds
- Stops the blame game in its tracks
 - Submit to God
 - Resist the enemy
 - Then he must flee
